## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

From the Assorted 8 Fat Quarters cut: (If using more than 8 prints, make sure when you are cutting that the 2 - 5" squares and the 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle are all cut from the same print) A: 9 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square B: 5" squares C: 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

From the **CREAM HOLLY PRINT**, cut: 1 - 13" square

From the SMALL BLACK PRINT, cut

4 - 2  $\frac{3}{4}$  x 44" strips and cut into 12 -2  $\frac{3}{4}$  x 11  $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the, cut: LARGE BLACK PRINT, cut:

4 - 9  $7\!\!\!/\!\!\!/_8$  x 44" strips and cut into 16 - 9  $7\!\!\!/_8$  squares

Fabric Requirements: Assorted Fat Quarters: Minimum of 8 (I used more for a scrappier look) Scraps for Holly Berries and Leaves Cream Holly Print: 1 fat quarter (5147/44) Small Black Print: <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard (5148/99) Large Black Print: 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards (5149/99) Inner Border: <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard (5150/88) Outer Border: 1 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards (5144/99) Stripe Binding: 1 yard(5145/9) Backing and Batting: 75" x 96"

From the INNER BORDER, cut: 7 - 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 44" strips

From the **OUTER BORDER PRINT**, cut:  $8 - 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 44" strips

From the **BLACK AND WHITE STRIPE**, cut: 2 - 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 18 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" & 2 - 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 13" Cut 9 - 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 44" strips for binding

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

**1.** Border the 13" center square with the black stripe  $2 - 3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 13" &  $2 - 3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " as shown. Appliqué the holly berries and leaves to the center block using desired method. Refer to the color photo as needed for placement. (The templates do not include a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, so you will need to add that if you plan to turn the edges under.)





2. Draw a diagonal line across the back side of the assorted colored 9 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares. Lay right sides together with the large black floral 9 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square. Sew <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" away from either side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and **press the seams toward the black**.

The blocks should measure 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".





**4.** Sew all of the blocks together into rows and sections as shown. Sew the rows together. The quilt should now measure  $54 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $72 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

**5**. Sew all of the inner border strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at 72  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 59" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

**6**. Sew all of the outer border strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at 77" and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 73" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

7. Quilt as desired and bind using the black stripe 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strips.
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
