CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:
From the Assorted 8 Fat Quarters cut: (If using more than 8 prints, make sure when you are cutting that the 2-5" squares and the $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11$ 1/2" rectangle are all cut from the same print)
A: $97 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square
B: $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares
C: $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$
From the CREAM HOLLY PRINT, cut: 1-13" square
From the SMALL BLACK PRINT, cut
4-2 3/4" x 44" strips and cut into $12-23 / 4$ " x $11 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
From the, cut: LARGE BLACK PRINT, cut:
4-9 $7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " strips and cut into $16-97 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Fabric Requirements:

Assorted Fat Quarters: Minimum of 8 (I used more for a scrappier look) Scraps for Holly Berries and Leaves
Cream Holly Print: 1 fat quarter (5147/44)
Small Black Print: $3 / 8$ yard (5148/99)
Large Black Print: $11 / 4$ yards (5149/99) Inner Border: $2 / 3$ yard (5150/88)
Outer Border: 1 7/8 yards (5144/99)
Stripe Binding: 1 yard(5145/9) Backing and Batting: 75" x 96"

From the INNER BORDER, cut: $7-23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From the OUTER BORDER PRINT, cut:
8-7 1 1 " $\times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From the BLACK AND WHITE STRIPE, cut:
2-3 1/4" x 18 ½" \& 2-3 1/4" x 13"
Cut $9-23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips for binding

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Border the 13 " center square with the black stripe $2-3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 13" \& $2-3 \frac{1}{4} " \mathrm{x} 18 \frac{112 "}{}$ as shown. Appliqué the holly berries and leaves to the center block using desired method. Refer to the color photo as needed for placement. (The templates do not include a $1 / 4$ seam allowance, so you will need to add that if you plan to turn the edges under.)
2. Draw a diagonal line acress the back side of the assorted colored $97 / \mathrm{m}^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Lay right sides together with the large black floral $97 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from either side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press the seams toward the black.
The blocks should measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Sew the small black print $23 / 4$ " $\times 111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips together with the colored $23 / 4 " \times 111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make 12 strip units as shown. Press the seams toward the black. Cut each one into $4-23 / 4 \prime \times 5$ " units. Sew these units together to make two 4-patch blocks. Sew together with the $5^{\prime \prime}$ matching colored squares. Press all seams as directed by arrows. The blocks should measure $91 / 2 "$.

4. Sew all of the blocks together into rows and sections as shown. Sew
 the rows together. The quilt should now measure $54 \frac{1}{2}$ x $72 \frac{1}{2}$ ". $\longrightarrow$
5. Sew all of the inner border strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at $721 / 2$ "and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at $59 "$ and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Sew all of the outer border strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at $77^{\prime \prime}$ and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at $73 "$ and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
7. Quilt as desired and bind using the black stripe $23 / 4$ strips.
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
