Children's Reversible Fat Quarter Apron







CHILDREN'S FAT QUARTER APRON

Size: 17" x 20"


Cutting Instructions:

From each of the **Apron Body** fabrics, cut: 1 - 17 ¹/₂" square 1 - 3 ¹/₂" x 17 ¹/₂" strip

From the **Apron Tie** fabric, cut: 3 - 3 ½" x 22" (or WOF) for the ties 2 - 6" x 9" pieces for the pocket (optional)

Assembly Instructions


1. Sew a contrast band to the bottom of the 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Add optional ric rac if desired (Place ric rac over seam, pin in place and topstitch edges down with matching color thread). Mark armholes as shown and trim. $5\frac{3}{4}$



Adding Optional Pocket: Mark and trim as shown below. Lay two pocket pieces right sides together and sew around the pocket, leaving the top open. Clip corners and turn right sides out. Using your fingers, pull excess fabric out of seam line and press so the edges lay flat. Tuck top edge under ¹/₄" and press. Position in place. Topstitch ¹/₈" from edges along the top, sides, and bottom, leaving the angled sides open.




2. Lay apron pieces **right sides together** and sew around apron with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance as shown, leaving the top open and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " openings for the ties right under the armhole.




3. Clip corners and turn apron right sides out. Using your fingers, pull excess fabric out of seam line and press so the edges of the apron lay flat. Tuck raw edges in $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press.

Fabric Requirements:


3 Fat Quarters - 2 for apron body and 1 for ties and optional pocket Optional: 1 ¹/₈ yards of jumbo ric rac Matching threads




5. Topstitch edges of armholes, leaving openings for the ties at the top and bottom of the armhole as shown.



6. Making the ties: Sew all of the $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips together end to end. Press seams open. Press the strip in half with wrong sides together, creating a crease along the bottom as shown.



Fold the raw edges in to meet the center fold line and press.



Fold the ends in $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Top stitch $\frac{1}{8}$ " away from the edges around the entire tie.



Slide ties through opening in apron and adjust to fit.
